

Structures, Renovations & Personal Property

- bringing unit, structures, decks, gazebos and accessories from the campsite, if required, within 24 hours upon notice from the Park Operator.
2. The camper must locate the camping unit on the campsite to the satisfaction of the Park Operator.
 3. Campsites are to be maintained in their natural condition.
 4. When vacating the campsite, it shall be restored as closely as possible to its natural condition.
 5. The following temporary and portable structures may be built upon written approval from the Municipal Office and will be inspected by Park Operator to ensure the structure adheres to size and portability: A). 64 square foot storage shed (eg. 8ft X 8ft) B). 120 square foot deck (eg. 10ft X 10ft) C). 120 square foot gazebo or dining tent (eg. 10ft X 10ft)
 6. All structures must be located so they do not create a safety hazard. All structures must be kept in good repair.
 7. The use of auxiliary refrigerators is permitted for an additional fee. The camper is responsible to maintain refrigerators in good running condition. The refrigerator is to be situated in a location that is not hazardous to neighboring campers, does not cause an obstruction of view and that is pleasing to the eye. The Park Operator has final approval of location.
 8. The use of all other large appliances (except barbecues) is prohibited outside the camping unit.
 9. No additional structures such as fish huts, fences, or hot tubs are NOT permitted.
 10. Written permission from the Municipal Office is required for bringing granular materials into the park.
 11. If your camper remains within the park beyond September 15th, and your winter storage fees have not been paid in full, arrangements will be made to have it removed at YOUR expense.
 12. If you are giving up your Seasonal Lot or you are a daily, weekly, monthly camper, please note: All additional structures - deck, gazebo, storage - MUST be removed when you leave the park. If they are left behind they become the property of the Municipality - Raven Park.

Swimming &

Boats

1. NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY
2. Swim at your own risk.
3. Children must be accompanied by an ADULT while using the beach and playground areas.
4. No boats are allowed in the designated swim area.
5. Check with the Park Operator about appropriate storage area for your boat trailer.
6. The limited shoreline and dock boat parking distribution list will carry over from the boat parking contest that occurred prior to the 2017 camping season. A waiting list will be maintained for anyone that is interested in a boat parking spot, but has been unsuccessful in obtaining one due to the limited availability.
7. We respectfully request that all boaters observe a "no wake zone" close to the beach and boat parking areas.
8. Swimming must only take place within the designated area. Please note that there is no lifeguard on duty and the beach is unsupervised.
9. Cliff jumping is not allowed.

Vehicles / ATVs / Bicycles / Motorized or Battery Operated Mobility Devices

1. The use of any vehicle, (including ATV's) under the influence, without a valid license or proof of insurance is prohibited.
2. Obey the park speed limits.
3. You must come to a full STOP at all STOP signs.
4. Parking is permitted only in designated areas and on the gravel portion of the campsite.
5. Parking is not permitted on the roadside.
6. ATV'S and similar vehicles may not be used within the park for recreational purposes.
7. Motocross and other off-road vehicles are PROHIBITED from use in the park.
8. Parking is NOT permitted at the dock area. The designated area at the dock is for launching your boat only.
9. The parking and/or storage of recreational equipment is to be limited to the campsite and shall not overflow onto other campsites, roadways or public property.

Waste Disposal

Please help us to keep the park clean by putting all garbage and recycling in the designated receptacles.

1. To avoid problems with nuisance animals such as bears and skunks, be sure to use the garbage containers provided and to maintain a clean campsite.
2. Household garbage must be deposited in an appropriate bear proof container.
3. Any items that are not acceptable with the municipal household garbage rules are the responsibility of the camper for proper disposal.
4. Do not clean fish at campsites. Please use the fish-cleaning hut.
5. Dumping of any grey water or black water in any place other than the approved dumping station (next to the washroom) will not be tolerated. Anyone found dumping either grey water or black water onto, or into, the ground will be evicted from the park without any refund or compensation.
6. Leaching pits are NOT permitted.
7. Hoses for black water tank flushing must be disconnected from the municipal water system when not in use. A double backflow preventer is required on the hose line as a secondary security measure.

Wild Animals

To avoid problems with nuisance animals such as bears, raccoons, skunks, fox, etc. we ask the following:

1. DO NOT attempt to feed, touch or in any way approach these animals. (They may become aggressive and defensive).
2. DO NOT leave bags of garbage outside your camper.
3. DO NOT clean fish at your campsite.

Rules & Regulations for Raven Beach Park & Campground

General

If a camper(s) has any concern in regard to the rules of the park, the camper is encouraged to bring this concern to the attention of the Park Operator. If this does not lead to a resolution, the camper can bring the concern to the Municipal Office during regular operating hours for further investigation.

1. Monthly - Cancellation after 15 days is non-refundable.
2. Seasonal - Cancellation - prorated to a maximum of 50% of total seasonal rate including hydro costs.
3. All fees must be paid in advance of the camping season.
4. Winter storage fees must be paid in full prior to September 1st.
5. The Township of Larder Lake has a zero tolerance approach to the destruction of park facilities.
6. ATV'S and similar vehicles may not be used within the park for recreational purposes.
7. Drivers must obey the posted speed limits signs and be aware of pedestrians, especially children at all times.
8. Alcohol / Cannabis may only be consumed on a registered campsite.
9. Alcohol / Cannabis are not permitted in public areas including picnic shelters.
10. The growing of cannabis anywhere in the campground is strictly prohibited.
11. The use of banned or illegal substances is strictly prohibited in the park.

Check-Out Time

1. Check out time is 1:00PM.

Other campers with reservations make it necessary that you observe the 1:00pm check-out time as a matter of courtesy.

Please advise the Park Operator if you wish to extend your stay. Availability of additional nights is not guaranteed.

2. All rent is payable in advance.
3. User stay permit must be on display and visible at all times.

Children

A child is considered anyone under the age of 14.

1. Parents are responsible for the actions and safety of children at all times.
2. Children are not to be left unattended in the campground, park or beach area.

Conserve Energy

Please help us to conserve escalating hydro costs by preventing excess use of air conditioner units.

1. The use of auxiliary refrigerators is permitted for an additional fee.

Fire, Fireworks & Firearms

1. All fires should be contained in a fire pit. The fire pit does not need to be manufactured or purchased however it must be suitable to contain the fire from spreading along the ground.
2. Campers should have a pail of water available to extinguish any fires if they become out of control.
3. The Larder Lake Fire Department is authorized to inspect any fire pit that is used within the park.
4. Fire bans declared by the Ministry of Natural Resources or the Larder Lake Fire Department will be enforced.
5. Keep your campfire small and be aware that it is a serious offence to leave your campfire unattended.
6. To preserve vegetation and ground cover please do not gather firewood from the area around your campsite, including cutting trees. Please ask the Park Operator before you remove any trees from your site.
7. Consult with the Park Operator for authorization of use of fireworks. Unauthorized use of any form of fireworks (fireworks, fire-crackers, flares, sparklers etc.) is prohibited.
8. FIREARMS ARE PROHIBITED.

Guests & Visitors

Registered campers are responsible for their guests and visitors behavior. Any guest or visitor disturbing others or breaking park rules will be asked to leave.

1. All visitors and guests are required to report to the front office.
2. All daily visitors must leave the park by midnight.
3. All overnight guests must be registered with the Park Operator, and the occupant must be onsite while their guest and/or visitor are onsite.
4. Maximum of SIX GUESTS per campsite.
5. Maximum stay of your guests is 10 consecutive days.

Noise

1. Excessive noise is not permitted at any time.
2. Quiet Time is to be experienced from 11:00 PM to 11:00 AM. (** Special Events are to be organized with the Park Operator and may run past 11:00PM.**)
(** Notice of Special Events will be provided to campers ahead of time. **)

Pets

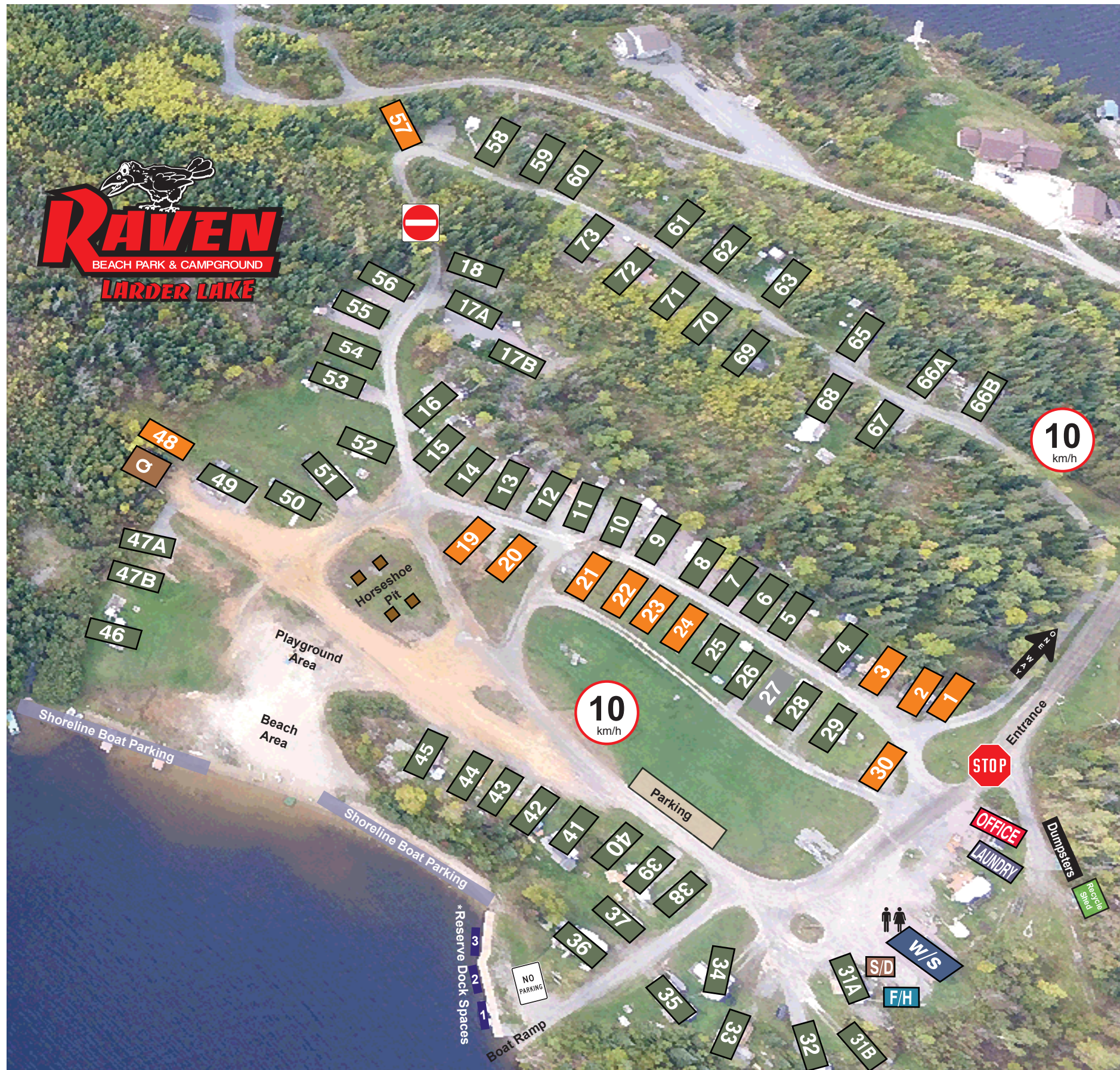
If your pet shows aggression toward another pet or person, you will be required to remove your pet from the park and your pet will not be permitted back into the park.

1. We limit the number of pets per campsite to TWO.
2. Pets and service animals must be on a leash at all times. NO EXCEPTIONS!!
3. Pets are not allowed in the beach area, children's park or park buildings (except for service animals)
4. You are responsible for your pet and service animal's behavior.
5. You must collect and dispose of their excrement appropriately.
6. Proof of vaccination must be readily available.
7. Proof of service animal designation must be readily available.

Speed Limit

The maximum speed limit within the park is 10KMH. Violators will be asked to leave immediately.
